#### Marine Science and Technology

#### MS&T executed significant initiatives to clean and preserve coastlines across multiple states



Reinstated: in-person internship and in-person volunteer programs since 2019, hosting dozens of in-person interns and volunteers, contributing to scientific research and community outreach **Executed**: dozens of <u>Community Coastal Cleanups</u> and <u>Company Community Service Cleanups</u> with volunteers removing hundreds of pounds of marine debris collected and removed from North Shore beaches **Hosted:** the <u>Clean Coast Coalition's</u> inaugural season in partnership with Keep Massachusetts Beautiful, using a <u>PixieDrone</u> device to combat marine debris

**Collected:** thousands of points of data were collected for several marine science science projects we manage


